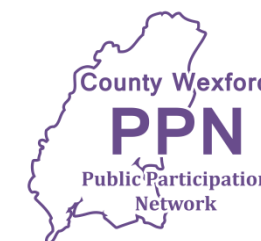

Chief Superintendent's Report	<p>Summary of crime stats provided for 2017 which showed increases in burglaries, car theft, domestic violence Property crime was down, while public order and drug detection remained the same. In traffic offences increases were seen in seat belt and mobile phone offences and significantly in drink driving - up from 287 to 338. Speed offences were down. There were 125 drug tests, leading to 13 arrests.</p> <p>Plans for the future were set out including increasing the number of Community Guards and introduction of a specialised protective service unit to cover child neglect, abuse etc.</p> <p>The Chief Superintendent announced it as his last meeting due to retiring in March and numerous committee members thanking him for his work and wishing him well.</p>
