On the municipal district reports the committee are waiting on some reports to be submitted.

Inspector Graham Rowley informed the meeting that the Garda youth awards will be made in October.

The committee welcomed the new Chief Superintendent Anthony Pettit attending his first JPC meeting and provided an update on policing matters
