
Wexford PPN 2023 Summary


- Hosting of an in-person Plenary meeting COMPLETE

- Full review and redevelopment for all of Wexford PPN's IT & Social Media platforms – ONGOING/COMPLETE




- Promotion of Wexford PPN at various Spring / Early Summer shows COMPLETE
